Plaque for Reg.#26112 Corporal Robert Gordon TEATHER, Cross of Valour (CV), RCMP LSM

Irwin AXNESS, past president, reported that the Beechwood Cemetery in Ottawa would accept a plaque honouring Cpl TEATHER. The cost of the plaque would be \$1,100. Beechwood will supply labour for installation and posts.

Cpl. TEATHER is the only member of the RCMP to receive the Cross of Valour, Canada's highest award for bravery. A new Coast Guard patrol ship has been named after him.

The award was for his actions in the rescue of two people from the hull of a capsized fishing boat on the morning of September 26th 1981.

Cpl. TEATHER passed away on November 14 2004. Irwin has not received a response regarding the plaque from the Depot cemetery.

It is noted that CVI members are more likely to visit the Depot cemetery than the Beechwood in Ottawa.


