In the year 2024, the RCMP Veterans' Association – Ottawa Division will be awarding eight (8) \$1,000 education awards.

The selection of the candidates will be based on equal opportunity and in accordance with the following criteria and procedures:

- 1) The student must be <u>under 25 years</u> of age and must be <u>accepted</u> at, or must <u>attend</u> a post-secondary institution (university, college or other recognized educational facility) on a full-time basis, leading to a degree, a diploma or a certificate.
- 2) The student can be already attending one of the above listed educational facilities (any year) or can be entering from high school.
- 3) Education awards are available to dependants and grandchildren of **ALL RCMP EMPLOYEES** (RM, CM, PSE) and **VETERANS** in the National Capital Region and Lanark County.
- 4) This Education Fund is totally separate from the RCMP Scholarship Program funded from the Benefit Trust Fund which is available throughout the Force to dependants of members (RM & CM) and former members.
- 5) The period for submission of applications is July 1, 2024 to September 1, 2024.
- 6) All applications will be verified for eligibility and placed in a single container. Eight (8) names will be drawn from the container during the RCMP Veterans' Association Ottawa Division, Regular General Meeting (RGM), date to be determined. The winners will be announced on our website at: https://ottawadivisionvaweb.site/education-awards/
- 7) Payment will be made directly to the recipient upon proof of registration.
- 8) Applicants may receive an Education Award only <u>once</u> from the RCMP Veterans' Association Ottawa Division Education Fund Program.
- 9) Only <u>one</u> application permitted per student.
